

# HTS IS OFFERING A DOT HAZMAT SHIPPER TRAINING



## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Federal DOT (Department of Transportation) regulations require training (and retraining) of all employees who perform work functions covered by the Hazardous Materials Regulation (HMR; 49 CFR 172.704). Any employee who may be involved in preparing or transporting hazardous materials is considered a “hazmat” employee and is required to have such training. This includes preparing hazardous waste for shipment or signing the uniform hazardous waste manifest upon pick-up.

A HAZMAT employee is one who directly affects hazardous material transportation safety and must be trained in accordance with the standard.

This includes any individual who:

- Loads, unloads or handles hazardous materials (including waste for shipment)
- Tests, reconditions or repairs HAZMAT containers
- Prepares HAZMATs and or WASTE for transportation (labels, shipping papers)
- Operates a vehicle containing HAZMAT (including deliveries)
- Is responsible for the transportation safety of HAZMAT

**Because so many of HTS’s customers are required to have DOT certification training solely for the shipment of their HAZARDOUS WASTES for disposal, our session includes additional information specific to the handling, storage and accumulation of WASTES.**
