Generators of hazardous waste must ensure that all employees involved in the management of hazardous wastes are thoroughly familiar with proper waste handling and emergency procedures in accordance with Title 22 § 662265.16 and 40 CFR § 262.34. LQG personnel must successfully complete a program of classroom and hands on instruction within six months of employment or assignment. This standard also requires an annual review of initial training.

Who Should be Trained? Anyone responsible for the management, collection, accumulation or handling of hazardous wastes for your facility.
